

Managing your CRC obligations

Phased Implementation and Reporting

Climate change affects all parts of the economy. With movement towards a carbon-constrained world, the UK government has committed to driving energy efficiency and carbon reduction across the UK economy. This is intended to help both increase energy security and decouple the economy from carbon.

The latest initiative to emerge from this policy is the Carbon Reduction Commitment (CRC) which focuses on the 5000 high energy using companies that fall below the threshold for the European Emissions Trading Scheme, and aims to encourage them to achieve energy efficiency for their operations.

This phased programme of workshops and support sessions is designed to help organisations to understand the requirements of the CRC and take them through a step by step process of establishing a robust :

- inventory of eligible emissions sources;
- data management systems and processes required to deliver legal compliance;
- integration with existing formal systems such as ISO14001 and ISO9000
- internal assurance and control (including internal audit)

This programme runs as a series of workshop, each workshop is followed by an action oriented task(s) for the delegates to undertake on their own organisations, upon completion of which there is a “surgery” session to review and obtain feedback on the implementation of each task.

This programme can be delivered as a bespoke series for individual clients, or may run as a “cluster” programme with a number of different organisations participating in the workshops and “surgeries”

Delegates do not require any prior knowledge of the CRC, emissions accounting and management to attend this programme. But they are expected to be in a position where the “action tasks” are under their responsibility in order that the programme can deliver tangible results. An indicative programme is given overleaf.

Workshops for the “cluster” format are normally held at the Warwick Business School, Coventry. UK; bespoke courses can be arranged in a venue to suit the client, subject to suitability for training purposes.

Dates of publicly available “cluster” programmes will be published on our website and will be notified to clients that have expressed interest in the courses. Bespoke courses can be arranged at any time, by mutual agreement.
